The attached application form is required of all upper division students (Design 5-9).

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: This is an information sheet to assist you through a dual application process; one for the University and the other for the School of Architecture (SOA).

1. FAU Admission

- All students **must first** apply to and be admitted to Florida Atlantic University. The University application may be obtained through the Admission's Office or via the FAU website. The University application must be sent to the Admission's Office. **DO NOT** send it to the School of Architecture, the School will NOT forward the application.
- Official transcripts must be submitted to the Admissions Office from every university/college attended. Please be aware of the immunization, foreign language, CLAST, general education and continuous enrollment policies of FAU. Meeting these requirements does not guarantee admission into the Bachelor of Architecture program.
- FAU, the School of Architecture, and the State of Florida Architectural Licensing Board require transcripts from Non-US Institutions to be evaluated course by course, including the GPA, by a professional evaluation service. A service can be found at www.naces.org.
- International students for whom their language of instruction was not English must submit TOEFL scores of 550 or higher.
- All FAU applicants must have an overall GPA of 2.0 or above.
- The University application must be submitted one month prior to the SOA Application and Portfolio submission deadline. Consult with the University Catalog for relevant dates.

2. SOA Program information, academic requirements and admission procedures:

- FAU's Bachelor of Architecture program requires completion of a minimum of 159 credit hours.
- Students applying for a second bachelor degree must complete a minimum of 33 credits at FAU. This will include all prerequisites and required courses for the entire bachelor program as listed on the School of Architecture website and in the catalog.
- All applicants must complete all prerequisites prior to beginning the design sequence at FAU.
- Only grades of 'C' or better will be accepted for any architecture course (no 'C-' grades).
- All applicants must submit a portfolio for faculty review and design sequence placement. Check the website or catalog for due dates.
- The School of Architecture's Admission Committee will determine the admission status of each applicant to the program via a review of the application materials and the portfolio. *Admission to the University as a pre-architecture student does not guarantee admission to the Bachelor of Architecture program.*

3. Checklist and items required with SOA Application and Portfolio:

- Obtain unofficial copies of all your transcripts and make photocopies. Do not submit the only original transcript copy with your SOA application materials.
- Highlight each pre-requisite and junior/senior phase course taken on each transcript where it appears. If you have taken a course more than once, highlight the highest grade.
- Out of State and International Students:
- Obtain an outline of the architecture program from the previous institution(s) attended. **(International students must provide a translation of the program outline, it is not written in English.)**
- Obtain course descriptions for each highlighted course. **(International students must provide translations of course descriptions if they are not written in English.)**
- Clearly and accurately record the information on the appropriate areas in the attached Application Form.
